Using the Concrete Mixer

- 1. Wear protective equipment including ear protection, dust mask, goggles, gloves and safety boots/wellingtons.
- 2. The engine must be running all the time there is a mix in the drum.
- 3. Do not move the concrete mixer while the drum is full.
- Stop the engine if leaving the machine unattended.
- As soon as work is finished the mixer and especially the inside of the drum must be washed clean before the mix hardens.
- 6. If the equipment does not work properly do not attempt to repair it. Contact the hire company.
- 7. You may want to read this leaflet again. Please keep it safe until you finish work.
