

# 0222 Safety Guidance



### **Using Masonry Saw Bench**

- Protective equipment must be worn including ear defenders, dust mask and goggles
- Switch off and wait for the machine to stop completely before making adjustments or fitting or changing the wheel
- Check that the cutting wheel is fitted correctly and that the guard is properly adjusted.
- If using water as a coolant or lubricant, check it is flowing correctly.
- Make sure that the saw is running at full speed before starting to cut.
- Be prepared for the reactive force when the wheel contacts the surface to be cut.
- If the saw starts to labour and slow down, do not force it so hard. Do not overload the saw. Keeping the wheel speed p is more effective than aggressive pressure
- The machine can only cut in straight lines. It should not be used to cut round corners.
- 10. Stop the saw if someone approaches the work area.
- 11. Switch off and unplug before leaving the masonry saw bench unattended.
- 12. If the equipment does not work properly, do not attempt to repair it. Contact the hire

## **Masonry Saw Bench**

The rules and procedures in force where people are at work may require the person responsible for this equipment to carry out a specific risk assessment.

#### It is important to read all of this leaflet **BEFORE using the Masonry Saw Bench**

- 1. Electricity is dangerous and must always be used with great
- This masonry saw is designed to cut blocks of concrete, masonry, brick, and, similar materials using the appropriate abrasive or diamond wheel.
- The action of this masonry saw bench could cause injury or damage if the machine is not used in a careful and controlled
- If the masonry saw has not been used before, the operator should familiarize themselves with the machine on some straightforward work before starting on the main task
- The work should be planned and thought out to ensure that the work is carried out safely.
- The following personal protective equipment should be worn as a minimum: Impact resistant goggles: EN166 - B or BS2092 grade 1; Dust mask – a minimum of EN149 FFP3(s) protection.
